APRIL FEATURED POSSE MEMBER GHISLAINE DEKONING



Ghislaine recalls her first ride on horseback happening at the age of 6. She was at the family farm in France. Draft horses were used in the fields for farm work and at the end of the day they would go out to the fields to return the horses back to the stables. She recalls being thrown upon horse bareback and being led back to the stables via the town centre fountain which was a communal water trough for all the

farm animals. After the horses had their fill they return to the stalls and Ghislaine laughingly recalls having to duck so didn't hit her head on the top of the door.

Her family moved to the states and into their country home in Mettawa in 1968. Their family befriended neighbors the Juhrends (posse members) and got their first horse Martini from them. One horse and two girls they often rode the horse together (sister Marie France) with Ghislaine at the reigns as she was "the older sister". They would ride many of the then open properties in the area including then Daniel Wright Woods. She says "we were like wild Indians riding all over the area". The Juhrends spoke highly of the then "Lake County Sheriff's Posse" and convinced them to join. Ghislaine took English riding lessons from a trainer Don Peebles in Harms Woods at the age of 7.

Some of her early favorite Posse memories were the Play Nights at the Libertyville Saddle Shop. She recalls being out past midnight was standard as the Posse parents had as much fun as the kids did! Ghislaine recalls her very 1st ribbon, the water race and she took 4th place and she'll never forget it. A few more fond memories include a ride down by the Lake Shore in Chicago with the mounted police. After riding down by the lake and along the lake front paths a few hours they were returning to the trailers and suddenly her horse toss her off! Unrelenting she held on to the reigns until on broke and off "Pebbles" went straight to a mounted policeman. Ghislaine felt it was an act of self preservation. She surmises the event is Gordon Turnbulls fault as he took her to the ride, similarly he took his daughter Susan the prior time and she was tossed off and acquired a broken arm. Nextly a few memories of fall rides: one memory where they used to prepare hundreds of steaks for riders she recalls the then president Carl Heinrich coercing Chef Karl (a popular restaurant in Libertyville) to come to the ride and cook the steaks and another fall ride there was an abundance of rain and the creeks were full. She recalls Marie France and Mary Jo Wignot riding their ponies thru water up to their saddles!!

Ghislaine has served the Posse abundantly! She recalls first being on the board, then chairing the Posse horse show after Laura Paukner resigned, and since partnering with many dedicated members to keep it running. She also serves on the North American Spotted Draft Horse Association as treasurer in addition to helping the "Border Run" association that formed to promote open horse shows in northern Illinois and southern Wi, notably they have 40 horse shows a year participating!! Ghislaine is currently our clubs treasurer and has done so off and on for many years!

Ghislaine met her husband Gerrit at the Juhrends place where he was training two mares to drive. I asked her if it was love at first site and she replied "it was something at first site!" With his European upbringing and love of horses (being a 9th generation horse and cattle dealer in Holland) they had a lot in common. She recalls one of their 1st dates he picked her up in horse and carriage and they went for a picnic in Wright Woods.

Ghislaine currently lives on a 10 acre property in a home built in 1909! She cares for sheep, goats, chickens, 3 donkeys and rabbits. Her two horses are Lady Hawk 26, and Tess 24, 50/50 Percheron Paints.

In closing she shared her most memorable Posse Person was Bob Park, "he helped me most with horse knowledge and in 4H" and then with a warm and kind smile says "I really don't know where I would be today if we hadn't joined the Posse… the Posse is my family."
